



HLTA STATUS COURSE

Does your school struggle to find teaching staff to cover PPA, INSET and sickness?
Do you want to offer career progression to your excellent support staff in your school?

The Saffron Teaching School Hub is working in partnership with Best Practice Network (BPN) to deliver the **Higher-Level Teaching Assistant (HLTA) Status** course in the Autumn term 2021.

This **seven-part course** will be delivered **online** and is aimed at Teaching Assistants looking for the next step in their career. HLTAs can teach whole classes under the direction of the class teacher, saving your school money on cover.

HLTA is a nationally recognised professional status which benefits staff and schools, enhancing knowledge, expertise and skills in supporting learning and reducing teacher workload. HLTA Status provides greater opportunities for support staff to increase their skills and confidence

The course consists of seven online sessions delivered throughout the Autumn term as follows:

- Five half-day sessions delivered by Essex specialist Sue Brown who will guide the Teaching Assistants through the individual tasks and will be on hand for any questions/help throughout the course.
- Two all-day sessions delivered by Best Practice Network.
- Participants must attend all seven sessions.

Assessment

On completion of the course, participants will be assessed and awarded the HLTA status.

£1,050 per participant (there will be an additional charge of £25 to take the required English or Maths test or £40 to take both tests.)
